Learning Objectives for the 2nd Annual Jefferson Sialendoscopy Course

At the conclusion of this CME activity, participants will be able to:

- Develop strategies to treat and manage salivary gland disorders.
- Examine the advantages of sialendoscopy and identify patients for whom this minimally invasive procedure would be most appropriate.
