

# CELL PHONES, PDA'S, LAPTOPS, DIGITAL READERS

Cell phones, personal digital assistants and other similar devices may only be used in the Business Center or private meeting rooms except that the brief and discrete use of cell phones and PDA's, are permitted but discouraged, in the Smoking Room, Business Café (located in the back of the Old Café) and the main hallways. Reading with digital readers is permitted in all areas of the League House. Laptops and other similar devices may only be used in the Business Center, the Business Café and private meeting rooms. The use of speakerphones is prohibited, and all cell phone, PDA, and laptop alerts must be silenced throughout the League House except in private rooms.

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# DRESS CODE POLICY

**FOR MEN:** Jacket and collared shirt are required at all times on the first floor members-only section of the League House. Jacket and tie are preferred.

**FOR WOMEN:** Dresses, blouses and skirts, or pants suit are appropriate attire. Pants should be tailored and are acceptable when worn with a jacket or other garments which would be appropriate if worn with a skirt.

## EXCEPTIONS:

- *1862 by Martin Hamann* - Jacket required at all times (including summer). Jacket and tie are strongly preferred.
- Breakfast - Business Casual attire is acceptable in *Founders* and *Café Meredith* for breakfast only.
- Private Dining/Meeting Rooms - Business casual attire is acceptable in private meeting rooms and for private dining events.
- Summer Dress - Except for *1862*, business casual attire may be worn throughout the League House from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
